
A **Community Health Worker (CHW)** is a frontline public health worker who is a trusted member of the community they serve. They serve as liaisons, guiding individuals and families through health, social, and community services systems to foster health and well-being. They are known by other names as well:



81% of CHWs in DE have received Core Competency training.

There are currently 4 CHW Core Competency training providers in Delaware. Each one utilizes established national core competency standards.


