



WE ARE HIRING

Attachment and Biobehavioral Catch-up (ABC) Parenting Institute is hiring part-time ABC parent coaches willing to visit homes in Delaware.



- This is a part-time position with hourly pay.
- Hours will vary based on caseload and parent coach's interest. We anticipate the parent coach might carry a caseload that would result, on average, 10-15 hours of work each week. There is the flexibility to increase hours based on parent coach interest and organization needs.
- Parent coach will be expected to complete ABC sessions in the early evening (e.g., 4-6:45pm) as requested.
- Commitment of one year requested. Flexibility to extend based on parent coach interest and organization needs.
- Parent coach will be compensated for travel time and reimbursed for mileage. Parent coach will need access to private transportation, such as their own car.
- Compensation is competitive and based on education and experience.
- Parent coaches will be hired across the state of Delaware, including New Castle, Kent, and Sussex county, to serve families within their geographic area.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Parent coach will be responsible for delivering Attachment and Biobehavioral Catch-up (ABC), an evidence-based home-visiting program for parents of children ages 0 through 4. ABC is a 10-session intervention focused on promoting responsive parenting. ABC can be delivered in-person or via Zoom. Although it is only 10 sessions long, ABC has impressive short- and long-term effects on child development. - ABC sessions will be scheduled at the parent coach and parents' convenience. Some work hours will occur in the early evening. Parent coaches who are willing to complete sessions on the weekend will receive increased compensation.
- Parent coach will receive 1.5 hours of weekly supervision. This supervision will be completed remotely via Zoom.
- Parent coach will be provided with all supplies that are required for ABC implementation.

EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE, AND ABILITIES:

- This position does not require a specific degree or education level. However, all applicants will need to participate in a screening interview to assess "goodness of fit" with the ABC model. This screening will occur via Zoom after an initial interview with ABC Parenting staff.
- Prior experience working with parents and young children is preferred.
- Our ideal applicant is organized and responsible, with good verbal communication skills and a warm but professional demeanor.
- Applicants with an interest in pursuing careers and/or graduate education in social work, public health, education, or psychology are particularly well-suited to this position.
